BE IT KNOWN THAT, by this INFORMATION Randy M. Fine as
the Complainant herein accuses MATTHEW T. RYAN the
above named Defendant with having committed the offense of
Resisting Arrest in violation of Section 205-30
Subdivision of the Penal Law of the
State of New York, a Class A/Misdemeanor

FACTS

The above said defendant at approx. 12:12pm on the 13th day of December, 1983,
and while operating NY REG: 8594AFD, a 1971 Saab, and while traveling on Bunn Hill
Rd, located in the Town of Vestal, County of Broome, State of New York, did
intentionally prevent, or attempt to prevent a police officer or peace officer from
effecting an authorized arrest of himself or another person to wit:
The aforesaid defendant, after being stopped by your deponent, a uniformed peace
officer operating a marked patrol vehicle with emergency lights turned on, did exit his
vehicle, denied to the peace officer that he, your deponent, had any right to stop him,
for a traffic violation, at which time the defendant re-entered his vehicle, left the
scene of the arrest at a high rate of speed and refused to stop for the aforementioned
police vehicle with emergency lights and sirens turned on for approximately 2 and 1/2
miles all contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.

The above allegations of fact are made by the Complainant herein
on direct knowledge (and upon information and belief, with the
sources of complainant's information and the grounds for his belief
being oral admissions of the defendant)



COMPLAINANT

Matthew T. Ryan

While on routine patrol in a marked patrol vehicle, alone, observed NY8594AFD pass a stop sign at the corner of the West Gym Spur and Bunn Hill Access Road, SUNY Binghamton. Stopped the vehicle on Bunn Hill Road, corner Bunn Hill Access, where the operator, later identified as Matthew T. Ryan (DOB 08/10/51) exited his vehicle and approached the patrol car, apparently very agitated. Ryan stated to the this officer that, "You have to have a reason to stop me! You dont have the authority to stop me!" Ryan then returned to his vehicle and left the scene of the arrest prior to being issued UTT's and released. This officer then gave chase using full emergency lights and siren. Ryan proceeded south on Bunn Hill Road and turned right on to Lauderdale Road. This officer maintained distance of approximately 25 feet behind Ryan at all times during the 2 and 1/2 mile pursuit which led us to Brown Road at its conclusion. During the pursuit, Officer Robinson, informed me that Ryan is a Karate expert. Vestal PD was contacted for back-up.

After arriving at Ryans' residence, in a very secluded area, both he and I exited our vehicles. I said to him, "You are under arrest, put your hands on the trunk." His response was "Fuck You," and he walked into his house. Approximately 8 minutes later the first VPD car arrived and all VPD officers entered the house and ~~exited with Ryan~~. Subject brought to Vesal Court for immediate arraignment on the following charges, 1) resisting arrest, 2) failure to stop, stop sign, 3) speed in zone and 4) uninspected motor vehicle.
